PeaceTrees Vietnam and the Vietnam National Mine Action Center

On the morning of March 14 in Hanoi, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was signed between PeaceTrees Vietnam and the Vietnam National Mine Action Center (VNMAC)! This continued partnership will help PeaceTrees expand our mine action programs, implement more explosive ordnance risk education (EORE) activities, collaborate to train more Explosive Ordnance Disposal technicians, and apply new technologies to mine clearance. PeaceTrees is honored to have VNMAC's, support and we look forward to working together to create a brighter future in Vietnam.

Burning Rocket Safely Destroyed near Quan Hau Market

While searching for oysters in the Nhat Le river, a fisherman encountered a long metal object and removed it from the water. After placing the object near the Quan Hau Market nearby, it began producing white smoke, that is when members of the Quan Hau Town People's Committee called the Quang Binh mine action hotline. PeaceTrees EOD technicians arrived shortly after, and identified the object as a White Phosphorous MK 67 rocket. After safely stopping the release of this toxic gas, the teams were able to move the rocket 2 km away from the market for a controlled detonation where the rocket was destroyed immediately. PeaceTrees is grateful for the local community in Quan Hau who knew exactly what to do upon realizing this object was an item of explosive ordnance!
