Program Update: Completion of the Prin Thanh Kindergarten



We are excited to announce that the construction of the Prin Thanh Kindergarten in Quang Tri Province has been completed in time for the 2020-2021 school year! On the first day of school, September 8th, teachers welcomed 30 students, ages 3-4, to the new classroom. Our team visited the new students and gifted them care packages for the new year including milk, snacks, toys and foam carpets for the children to sit on. Thanks to the support of a matching grant that we received through One Day's Wages and the dedication and generosity of the Hayward family and many other donors, children will have a safe place to learn and play in Prin Thanh Village for years to come.

Project Update: New Water Well in Ta Long Village



Earlier this month, local authorities in Quang Tri Province certified the water quality of a new PeaceTrees sponsored well in Ta Long Village! This certification confirms the water is clean and safe for people in the community to use. As a result, 72 community members will have direct access to safe water. 
